2. If this Official signed the grant Application Electronic Authorization prior to the passage of this Resolution, this grant of authority applies retroactively to the date of signing.
3. If the applicant is awarded a grant, the Grant Application Electronic Authorization, signed by the above Official, will become the applicant/grantee’s executed signature page for the Grant Agreement, and the applicant/grantee will be bound by the Grant Agreement.
4. Any amendments to the Grant Agreement may be signed on behalf of the grantee by the Official who, at the time of signing of the amendment, has the “Title” specified in paragraph 1 and the grantee will be bound by the amendment.

**AUTHORIZE APPROVAL TO PROHIBIT PARKING ON THE LEFT SIDE OF PINE
STREET FROM S. 2nd STREET TO JOHN BOSACCO PARK**

BE IT RESOLVED, pursuant to Vehicle Code (Title 75) of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, 75 Pa.C.S.A § 6109 Colwyn Borough has the authority to regulate and prohibit the stopping/standing and/or parking of vehicles on roadways under its jurisdiction and by the Council of the Colwyn Borough, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, meeting in public session on this day, April 16, 2026, that it does hereby authorize the following:

Section 1. Parking Prohibited. Parking shall be prohibited on the left side of Pine Street from S. 2nd Street to Bosacco Park.

Section 2. Signs. The Colwyn Borough Public Works Department is hereby authorized to create and erect “No Parking” signs along Pine Street from S. 2nd Street to John Bosacco Park.

Section 3. Enforcement. The Colwyn Borough Police Department is hereby authorized to enforce the prohibition on parking pursuant to the Borough Code.

Section 4. Effective date. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon passage.
