APPROVING APPOINTMENT OF PART-TIME PARKING ENFORCEMENT OFFICER**

WHEREAS, the Borough of Colwyn, Delaware County, Pennsylvania, is responsible for enforcing municipal codes and ordinances to maintain public health, safety, and welfare; and

WHEREAS, the Borough has determined that the appointment of a part-time Parking Enforcement Officer is necessary to ensure compliance with local ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the Borough will identify a qualified candidate to fulfill the duties of the part-time Parking Enforcement Officer position.

NOW, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Borough Council does give permission to the Colwyn Police Chief to advertise, interview and recommend for the position of Cowlyn Borough Part-time Parking Enforcement Officer, at the rate of \$15.00 per hour, with no benefits, to perform all duties as required of the position and as assigned. Candidate to be approved by Council at a subsequent meeting.
